**Justice Lindy Jenkins - Retirement**

The Hon Justice Lindy Jenkins has announced her retirement from the Supreme Court of Western Australia to take effect on 30 January 2020.

Justice Jenkins was appointed as a judge of the Supreme Court on 2 February 2004, prior to which her Honour served for more than two years as a judge of the District Court of Western Australia.

Chief Justice Peter Quinlan today congratulated Justice Jenkins on her exemplary service as a judge of the Court and her decades of service to the administration of justice in Australia as a lawyer and a judge.

“With her combined service on the Supreme Court and District Court, Justice Jenkins is currently the longest serving judge in Western Australia”, Chief Justice Quinlan said.

“During that time, her Honour has presided over many of the most important trials to come before the Court and has made a vital contribution to all aspects of the Court's work.”

“Not only has her Honour provided a model of dedicated judicial service to the community of Western Australia, Justice Jenkins has been a valued colleague and leader within the community of the Court. Her Honour's broader commitment to the administration of justice has been recognised at a national level, including as a council member of the Australian Institute of Judicial Administration.”

“On behalf of the entire Court, I thank her Honour for her outstanding contribution to the administration of justice in Australia and wish her well in her retirement from the Court.”
