Kiosks available – David Malcolm Justice Centre

The Supreme Court of Western Australia introduced kiosks in the Court's Registry in March 2018. The kiosks can be used by self-represented litigants (and other litigants) who need to present documents for filing, or access information from the Court's website. The kiosks may also be used to access the legal resources and databases that are available on the kiosks.

Since 1 March 2018, it has been mandatory to present documents for filing electronically using the Court's electronic document system (EDS), unless there is an exception under the *Rules of the Supreme Court 1971*, O 67A r 3(1). The EDS is the electronic filing system which may be accessed via the eCourts Portal of Western Australia website. A litigant must become a registered user of the eCourts Portal to use the EDS to electronically present documents for filing, and may register by using the kiosks in the Registry. Staff at the Supreme Court Registry can also provide information about the use of the kiosks and how to become a registered user of the eCourts Portal.
