Court of Appeal Judicial Exchange – Justice Philip Morrison

On Monday, 10 May 2021, Justice Philip Morrison, a judge of the Court of Appeal of Queensland, was sworn in as an acting judge of the Court of Appeal of Western Australia.

Justice Morrison's appointment is part of the judicial exchange initiative commenced by the two jurisdictions in July 2019. The programme has already seen the President of each court spend time sitting in the other jurisdiction.

The judicial exchange initiative allows courts in different states to share information and experience to better improve the delivery of justice to the community.

Justice Morrison is a graduate of The University of Queensland and was admitted as a barrister of the Supreme Court in Queensland in 1976. His Honour was appointed a judge of the Queensland Court of Appeal in 2013.

As a barrister, Justice Morrison gained extensive trial and appellate experience, appearing as lead counsel in various courts including the High Court.

His Honour will sit on cases in the Court of Appeal of Western Australia between 10 May and 21 May 2021.
