Call for Submissions - Legal Costs Committee

Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Act 2022

The Legal Costs Committee gives notice under section 139 *Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Act 2022* that it will conduct reviews and make determinations the three non-contentious business determinations it makes. These are:

- [Legal Profession \(Non-contentious Probate Costs\) Determination 2021](#), which covers all work done in obtaining a grant or re-grant of probate or letters of administration;
- [Legal Profession \(Public Notaries\) Determination 2021](#), which covers all work done by Notaries Public; and
- [Legal Profession \(Solicitors Costs\) Determination 2021](#), which covers all non-litigation work done by lawyers, including barristers, including leasing, banking, sales of land, drafting legal documents and so on.

The Committee welcomes submissions from interested people, who are invited to make written submissions about any aspect you would like the Committee to consider. Submissions must be relevant to the above determinations and should only deal with matters within the Legal Costs Committee's jurisdiction.
