Government House & the Supreme Court of Western Australia are jointly hosting a [Heritage Precinct Open Day](#) for the first time next Sunday, 19 October 2008.

Members of the public will be able to visit the historic Supreme Court, including the cells beneath the building, and hear talks by Judges of the Court. Visitors will be able to tour courtrooms and view judges' chambers inside the heritage-listed building on a [self-guided tour](#).

The adjacent 1837 courthouse, the oldest building in Perth, will also be open to the public.

People are also invited to tour the public rooms of Government House, the ballroom & the gardens, picnic on the lawns and enjoy the entertainment provided throughout the day.
