## **Bulletin No. 2: Supreme Court On The Move – 11 July 2016**

As outlined in our [previous bulletin](#), the Supreme Court's General Division is moving to the new David Malcolm Justice Centre, 28 Barrack St, Perth, on 11 July. The Court of Appeal remains in the Stirling Gardens courthouse, and all criminal hearings will continue to be heard at either Stirling Gardens or the District Court building.

Following the move on 11 July, the Supreme Court's new mailing address for all correspondence (including the Court of Appeal) will be at the David Malcolm Justice Centre. From 11 July 2016, the Court's postal address will be:

With Central Office, the Probate Office and the Criminal Registry combined into one registry in the new building, that registry will be known as the **Supreme Court Registry and Central Office**, and will be located on the 11<sup>th</sup> floor.

The Court of Appeal Office remains in its current location in Stirling Gardens.

The Chief Justice of Western Australia, the Hon Wayne Martin AC, will present a short talk on the new building for legal practitioners on Monday 18 July at 4.30pm. It will be held in the ceremonial courtroom on level 4 and will be followed by an introductory tour of other hearing facilities provided in the new building.
