State of Western Australia v Edwards – Information for the Public

The Supreme Court trial of Bradley Robert Edwards commenced on Monday, 25 November 2019 and is open to the public.

The trial is heard in Court 7.2 at the District Court building at 500 Hay Street, Perth. Seating in the public gallery is limited and is allocated on a first come, first served basis each day of the trial.

The trial was screened on monitors in Court 2 of the Supreme Court for the first week. From Monday, 2 December this stream will no longer occur and the only public gallery will be at the District Court.

Please note there is no onsite parking at the District Court. You will also need to go through airport-style security screening on arrival.

The trial will generally commence at 10.00 am each day. Members of the public are to be seated by 9.40 am (doors to the court room will be opened early to facilitate this).

Lunch adjournments will be between 1.00 pm and 2.15 pm. The proceedings will generally finish for the day by 4.30 pm.

Recording, sketching and note taking is not permitted (other than by permission of the trial judge, which is generally limited to the media).
