The Supreme Court of Western Australia will open its doors to the public for Open Day 2021 on Sunday, 18 April, between 11am and 3pm.

Take a self-guided tour of the court, including areas of the courthouse not usually open to the public. Visitors are invited to explore the grand 117-year-old courthouse in Stirling Gardens, inspect the cells below the building and view heritage-listed courtrooms and the Chief Justice's chambers.

Supreme Court judges will be present to answer questions and historic legal documents, drawings, court robes and wigs will be on show.

For the first time, historic trial audio and photos from the 1963 murder trial of serial killer Eric Edgar Cooke will form part of a special display.

Supreme Court Open Day is part of Heritage Perth Weekend – an event focussing on Perth's history and heritage.

The Old Court House Law Museum next door and many other heritage buildings around Perth will also be open.
