The Supreme Court of Western Australia Open Day for 2010 will be held on Sunday, 14 November from 11am – 4pm.

The Court is taking part in a weekend of events being organised for Heritage Perth's Heritage Days. The Heritage Days weekend will include walks, talks, tours, performances, music and activities for all ages, celebrating the people, places, buildings and events that have made Perth unique.

Members of the public will be able to once again visit the historic Supreme Court building, including the cells beneath the building, and hear talks by Judges of the Court. Visitors will be able to tour courtrooms and view judges' chambers inside the heritage-listed building.

Displays throughout the building will outline the Supreme Court's history.

The adjacent Old Court House Law Museum, the oldest building in Perth, will also be open to the public during the weekend. Constructed in 1836, it was the most prominent building in the early days of the Swan River Colony.
